

A Study on the Integration of Traditional and Modern Patterns in Guangfu

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Abstract: The traditional cultural elements of the Guangfu region are distinct and deeply rooted in the daily lives of local people, playing a crucial role in society. These cultural symbols, including various tangible and intangible customs, collectively form material and intangible cultural heritage with unique regional characteristics, providing rich inspiration and materials for modern pattern design. Based on this, this paper extracts and summarizes the patterns from traditional Guangfu clothing culture and modern patterns, conducts an in-depth comparative analysis between the two, and further summarizes and supplements the integration of traditional Guangfu clothing patterns with contemporary graphic design in China.

2. The Basis and Reasons for The Integration of Traditional Guangfu Auspicious Patterns into Modern Clothing Design

"Throughout its long historical development, Chinese clothing has undergone millennia of transformations. The attire practices of the Chinese people exhibit a stable and unchanging mentality. Regardless of dynastic changes, shifts in social customs, or alterations in clothing styles, the inner essence embodied in Chinese garments remains constant, possessing enduring stability [1]." From this statement, we can conclude that modern fashion design is rooted in traditional culture, which explains why Guangfu traditional patterns are selected as the source of inspiration for decorative motifs in contemporary clothing design. These traditional auspicious patterns from Guangfu not only enrich the monotonous structures of modern garments and enhance their visual appeal, but also embody the cultural significance embedded in attire.

Modern fashion design encompasses diverse dimensions, with consumers' choices being shaped by age groups, personal preferences, and individual tastes. 4. Characteristics of Traditional Clothing Patterns in Guangfu

First, the meaning of traditional Guangfu patterns:

The traditional auspicious patterns of China are a form of inheritance and expression of Chinese culture, embodying a spirit and philosophy that reflects beautiful aspirations. When designing these patterns, people integrate them with auspicious connotations through graphic representations,

expressing higher-level imagination about reality. By idealizing and personifying traditional motifs, they spiritually manifest the vision of harmonious unity between humans and nature—a prominent feature of traditional Chinese auspicious patterns.

Second, the structure of traditional Guangfu patterns:

The pattern is mainly structured with circles. Confucian culture has a great influence on traditional culture, advocating benevolence, righteousness, etiquette, wisdom and trustworthiness, and emphasizing harmony. "Harmony" represents roundness, and the characteristics of circular structure are consistent with the symbolic characteristics of "harmony".

Third, the expression techniques of traditional patterns in Guangfu:

Pattern design embodies the aspirations of working people through artistic expressions like metaphor, symbolism, distortion, homophonic play, and analogy, imbuing objects with auspicious meanings to convey their ideals. The laborers' pursuit of a better life has driven the evolution of auspicious motifs, enriched their symbolic significance and enhanced aesthetic appeal. As shown in Table 1.

5. Innovation and Change of Traditional Patterns and Modern Pattern Design in Guangfu

5.1. Innovative Design of Traditional Clothing Patterns on Modern Graphics

In the design of clothing, pattern, style and color are very important. The complex silhouette of clothing makes it weaker. However, with the development of economy, the silhouette of clothing is more and more simplified, its status

is improved, and its role of decoration is more and more strong.

The decorative beauty and auspicious symbolism of traditional patterns continue to inspire fashion designers. When creating "Guofeng" (Chinese-style) designs, designers often incorporate elements from these heritage motifs. By presenting their concepts through accessible forms that resonate with modern audiences, they make their works more approachable and appealing. Moreover, designers must carefully consider the symbolic meanings of patterns while adapting them to market trends. Through strategic extraction and creative recombination of these cultural elements, they craft designs that effectively capture consumer attention and achieve commercial success.

When adapting traditional patterns for modern fashion design, designers should strategically select specific elements or holistic features. By employing techniques such as points, lines, and planes, they can create abstract or realistic shapes that showcase decorative and visual appeal. During this process, elements should be organized through principles like exaggeration, contrast, symmetry, repetition, rhythm, and harmony. These aesthetic guidelines transform complex, irregular components into structured patterns with harmonious beauty, ensuring the entire design maintains cohesive unity.

Modern garment design mainly uses several design methods when extracting graphics, as shown in Table 2:

The vibrant colors of Guangfu's traditional patterns showcase distinct ethnic characteristics and serve as powerful decorative elements. As depicted in Figure 1, designer Shao Shiru employs traditional fabrics and classical craftsmanship, infusing modern aesthetics into garment cutting and color design. This innovative fusion achieves harmonious resonance between tradition and contemporary fashion, creating a refreshing visual experience. What viewers perceive are not merely garments, but tangible embodiments of historical and cultural heritage. Such profound cultural immersion evokes a profound sense of awe and inspiration.

Influenced by traditional aesthetic principles, Guangfu traditional patterns in China have long adhered to unique color coordination rules. To integrate these with modern trending colors, designers should strike a balance between three key elements: the inherent color schemes of traditional motifs, internationally recognized standard color palettes, and contemporary color trends. Only through this synthesis can designs meet modern aesthetic demands [4]. Moreover, "the

allure of color in marketing is a decisive factor in product sales and an indispensable element in design" [5]. The application of traditional pattern colors in fashion design directly impacts garment success and market performance. To align apparel with modern consumer preferences, designers must ensure harmonious integration between traditional motifs and contemporary textile colors while avoiding overly garish original hues. By employing modern color coordination techniques, designers can refine traditional auspicious patterns to enhance thematic focus and elevate garments' visual appeal [6].

In contemporary fashion design, traditional Guangfu attire patterns have transcended conventional craftsmanship. With technological advancements, these patterns now manifest through diverse techniques including embroidery, batik, tie-dye, openwork, and patchwork. Designers must thoroughly understand the visual outcomes of each technique. When integrating these patterns with modern garment graphics, the selection of techniques should be determined by the specific requirements of the design project. As shown in Table 3:
