

"Helping People Get Cheated" to "Anti-Fraud Star"

-- Reflections on ideological and political education from the perspective of campus Internet fraud cases

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Abstract: In recent years, there have been frequent cases of telecom network fraud. Because cunning crooks have long extended their claws to the pure campus. "Post-00" college students grow up in the Internet era and like to participate in online activities and online part-time jobs. In order to prevent college students from falling into the crisis of telecommunications network fraud, although colleges and universities have repeatedly reminded them of security education, the effectiveness of education still needs to be improved. Among them, the fake identity fraud encountered by Xiao Chen is a typical high-incidence telecom network fraud case. By analyzing the causes of cases, the case handling process of ideological and political workers is expounded, and the case reflection and enlightenment are summarized, which provides effective reference ideas for the prevention and control of campus online fraud.

Keywords: Campus network fraud prevention; Ideological and political education; Effective methods.

1. Introduction

Xiao Chen, a boy, who is a "post-00s" college student. In October 2020, Xiao Chen received a message from a familiar netizen with the game software in QQ, the other party said that his friend urgently needed money in the hospital. But due to the limited WeChat quota, he could not transfer money, and hoped to transfer to Xiao Chen by Alipay first, and then ask him to transfer to his friends through a bank card. Just when Xiao Chen hesitated, the other party sent a screenshot of Alipay successfully transferring 1,000 yuan, and sent a video of his injured friend, urging Xiao Chen to hurry up to transfer. However, as Xiao Chen successfully transferred, he found that the net friend sent a message in QQ space saying that his QQ number was stolen. Until this time did Xiao Chen realize that he was deceived and immediately called the police for help.

In recent years, telecom network fraud cases frequently, which are closely related to the cunning cheaters who have long been claws into the pure campus. According to the analysis of the 2021 Wenzhou teachers and students telecommunications network fraud cases, college students accounted for 15.8%, and the types of fraud ranked from the highest to the bottom are game equipment, fake identities, recharge rebate, part-time brushing and shopping consumption. The fake identity fraud encountered by Xiao Chen ranked second, which is a typical high-incidence telecom network fraud case.

2. Case analysis

2.1. Helpful but lacking social experience, he fell victim to "identity impersonation" scams

Post-00s college students are growing up in the Internet era and prefer to participate in online activities and part-time jobs. In the case of Xiao Chen being cheated, the friend he turned to for help was the virtual friend who he had never met in the game software. This shows that the Internet is no longer just

a medium of information, but it also gradually becomes a platform for life. However, due to his lack of social experience, risk awareness and prevention ability in the face of complex network environment, eventually Xiao Chen fell into the trap set by scammers [1].

2.2. The effect of traditional security education of telecom network fraud is not ideal

Despite the repeated reminders in security education at colleges and universities, the effectiveness of education still needs to be improved to prevent college students from falling into telecom network fraud. Xiao Chen had attended the security education lecture held by the school before he fell into a trap, which shows that traditional preaching cannot exactly penetrate into the hearts of post-00s college students.

2.3. Lack of home network risk management education

According to Xiao Chen's feedback during the conversation, his parents focused on traditional Chinese moral education, such as returning lost money and being ready to help others, but did not carry out network risk management education. Xiao Chen even doubted his quality of helping others after being duped. It can be seen that the lack of home network risk management education is also a significant factor in the high incidence of cases of telecom network fraud on campus.

3. Case process

3.1. Patience to heal the soul

Via talking with Xiao Chen as soon as possible, the deception process was understood in detail and the cheaters' "ingenuity" in this type of deception was summarized. Through cognitive behavioral therapy [2], Xiao Chen was led to correctly understand the root of the problem of being cheated on and help him out of the psychological haze of being cheated on. Then, in response to the high incidence of Internet fraud cases, in all classes of the school was

investigated one by one, which makes more like Xiao Chen in the telecom network fraud case victims of the students to get timely care.

3.2. Warm companionship and regain self-confidence

The basic work included hiring league branch secretary and publicity commissary of the class as anti-fraud liaison officers, organizing league and school backbone to set up a propaganda team of "You and I are of the same mind, anti-fraud colleagues" to go to bed for publicity. What's more, Chen and other cheated students were invited to script their own cheating experience and help shoot a series of micro-videos of network fraud cases. The micro video "online shopping information leakage - impersonating customer service fraud" was honored to be a part of the "Learning Power". Successfully, Xiao Chen gradually regained his confidence in the anti-fraud voluntary propaganda.

3.3. Meticulous care and self-improvement

In the anti-fraud volunteer publicity again and again, Xiao Chen's wounded soul was gradually healed. He recognized that helping others is the right thing to do, but the problem lies with the criminals involved in online fraud. Therefore, only by calling on more students to constantly improve the awareness of anti-fraud, in order to fundamentally eliminate telecom network fraud. So he combined his professional knowledge and worked with his classmates to independently develop the "No Fraud on Campus" mini program to serve the anti-fraud awareness of new students, which was widely reported by many media, such as "Zhejiang Workers' Daily" and "Qianjiang Evening News".

4. Conclusion

General Secretary Xi Jinping emphasized that "To do a good job in ideological and political work in colleges and universities, we must adapt to events, advance with the times, and adapt to the situation." When students are hurt by telecom network fraud, the top priority is to guide students to take advantage of the situation with love to care for the healthy growth of students.

(1) Adapt to events and help students get out of the haze

What we should do is to pay attention to the psychological state of the deceived students in a timely manner and conduct psychological counseling. To enhance the ability [3] of youth to prevent telecom fraud, we can strengthen their ideological education and psychological quality training. Ideological and political education in colleges and universities needs the concerted efforts of "counselors, parents and peers". In combination with the IT Culture Festival, we held the online anti-fraud short video solicitation contest to design new forms like "anti-fraud milk tea" that young people like, and regularly pushed online fraud cases on the department's wechat public account and set up a safety grid in dormitories, encourage dorm leaders to observe attentively and conduct timely counseling for possible Internet fraud hidden dangers. By writing a parents' notice to remind parents to control students' living expenses scientifically and reasonably and to cultivate

students' awareness of risk management. Thus, to prevent telecom network fraud, we must communicate well with parents and realize home-school linkage.

(2) Keeping pace with the times and rekindling students' volunteer spirit

Ideological and political workers in colleges and universities should keep up with the pace of the times and enhance the affinity and pertinence of ideological and political education, and accurately grasp the behavioral habits and psychological preferences of "post-00" college students. Guiding the deceived students to help shoot anti-fraud micro-videos based on their deception experience and seeking publicity methods that college students prefer to see in the era of integrated media which can make deceived students identify scammers in volunteer service and rekindle their self-confidence.

(3) Adapt to the situation and achieve dreams with the help of professionalism

We call on each class director, full-time teachers through the theme class meeting, curriculum ideological and political education links, using close face-to-face form, the Internet fraud case analysis to every student. At the same time, will test the true small program and other small anti-fraud program in the class meeting to demonstrate to each student. So the students in the transfer can further confirm the identity of the other party to prevent falling into fraud trap.

Students need to go through ups and downs to grow up. To turn danger into opportunity, crises into opportunities require ideological and political workers in colleges and universities to have dialectical thinking, develop new abilities based on the situation, and guide cheated students to develop anti-fraud mini-programs based on their professional knowledge. This not only enables the cheated students to innovate in their professional learning, but also helps the freshmen to investigate their anti-fraud awareness, laying a foundation for the establishment of a systematic education mechanism for college students to prevent network risks.

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
